LensCrafters Gift of Sight Program

Step 1: Students meet with an MATC counselor or advisor to obtain a letter, including the college's tax ID number, explaining that they need glasses and that they are unable to pay.

Step 2: The student calls their local LensCrafters (see below) and explains they are seeking an eye exam from the Gift of Sight (GOS) program, that they have a letter from MATC, and they want to schedule an appointment for an eye exam.

Step 3: The student brings the letter and attends the eye exam. LensCrafters will have a box of frames from which the student can choose. The lenses will be basic plastic lenses. They will not be high-index, transitions, or anything like that. But they will have your RX.

The eye exam and glasses are free of charge through Gift of Sight.

Students should not wait till their present glasses break and are mangled beyond all repair. They may not be able to get a GOS appointment same day. If it's been awhile since a student's last exam, or their glasses are a couple of years old, start now on getting the GOS glasses. Students who have never had glasses, but who need them, are also eligible.
