CONSTITUTION

Preamble

The Milwaukee Vocational Teacher's Association, Local 212, is organized not only for benefits to teacher-members which come from co-operative effort, but also for the improvement of the teaching profession to the end of better fitting students to enjoy life to its fullest and to make the students better members of the community.

Association members should interest themselves in community, state and national problems and work assiduously for the accomplishment of those things that will give opportunity of fullest expression to all.

Teachers have been isolated from the rest of society so that their understanding of social problems has been negligible. The organizers of this association feel that teachers, due to their pivotal positions, should use their best effort to lead and not to follow in the construction of an equitable society where no man is a serf and where hunger cannot stalk in the midst of abundance.
